4. Decisions taken at the Ordinary meeting	4.1 To approve the Minutes of the Ordinary Meeting on the 10 th November 2022 subject to the following amendment: - That Minute 171g be amended to include Cllr Craddocks suggestion of high level alarms to culvert screens indicating blockages
	4.2 To approve the Minutes of the Extraordinary Meeting on the 24 th November 2022 subject to the following amendments: - a) to amend the location of the meeting to the Welfare Hall, Abercrave. b) to amend a street name proposal for the old Penrhos School development site from Heol Coombe to Heol John Coombe.

	4.7 That the Clerk adjust all estimated figures for contracted works in 2023/24 from the previous financial year, by the Consumer Price Index of September 2022 of 10.1% in recognition of no contract cost increase given over the last four years.
	4.8 a) That applications to the Town Council Cost of living relief fund be limited to up to £1,500 per application and that evidence from an applicant

	of extra services provided and utilised by the community by means of the fund, be provided prior to consideration of any further applications. b) that financial assistance to applicants be awarded as follows: - Abercrave Happy Helpers - £1,300 Community Dreams - £1,000 Ystradgynlais Volunteer Centre (Foodbank) - £1,500 Ystradgynlais Welfare Hall - £1,500
