3. Declarations of Interests	Cllr M Allen declared a personal interest in an item under Correspondence regarding a boundary wall at The Welfare, Ystradgynlais
4. Decisions taken at the Ordinary meeting	a) To approve the Minutes of the Ordinary Meeting on the 1 st September 2022 subject to an amendment of Minute 94 to include the affirmation of the Councils previous resolve to request a meeting with a police representative concerning Coronation Park
	b) To defer the next Ordinary Meeting to Thursday 10 th November 2022
	c) To accept a contractors estimate of £2,200 for repairs to a wall at the Tick Tock site
	d) That a second estimate for the repair of the Ystradgynlais Welfare Hall boundary wall be awaited for decision to be taken at the next Ordinary meeting. Following this, that the repairs be commissioned at a 50/50 split financially between the Town Council and the neighbouring property owner replacing the wall like for like with no access point.
	e) To confirm and approve the action taken by the Chairman and Vice Chairman not to schedule an Extraordinary Meeting to deal with a deferred closed item due to the resident notifying the Town Council they would be seeking assistance from outside organisations
	f) Payment of accounts approved
	g) That clarification of Standing Order 4 concerning filming and recording of Town Council meetings be sought and that the item be placed on the Agenda for the November meeting
	h) That an information day at the Ystradgynlais Library to raise awareness of local support schemes and organisations able to assist with the Cost of Living crises, be publicised through the Town Council Facebook page
	i) That a draft Training plan be produced by the Clerk for consideration at the Ordinary Meeting in November
	j) To contact Powys County Council requesting information concerning the refurbishment of the Peace Memorial at Gorsedd Park
	k) That Cllr G Roberts will circulate information in anticipation of the 70 th anniversary of the Eisteddfod hosted at Gorsedd Park in 1954.

	l) That the Sitting Member and regional Ministers of the Senedd be contacted to voice the Town Councils concerns about the breach of planning conditions for the restoration at Nant Helen
	m) That item 9, a notice of motion from Cllr N Craddock who was absent at this meeting be deferred to the Ordinary Meeting in November
	n) To release the second instalment of allocated budgeted funding for 2022/23 of £14,000 to the Ystradgynlais Welfare Hall
