3.Declarations of Interest	There were no declarations of interest.
4.Decisions of the Council	4.1 Resolved that the minutes of the below meetings were confirmed as an accurate record and signed by the Chairman:- a) Abercrave Ward Committee Meeting on 4 th November 2025 b) Ystradgynlais Ward Committee Meeting on 4 th November 2025 c) Cwmtwrch Ward Committee Meeting on 4 th November 2025 d) Management Committee Meeting on 5 th November 2025 e) Ordinary Meeting on 13 th November 2025 f) Ynyscedwyn Ward Committee Meeting on 2 nd December 2025 g) Management Committee Meeting on 3 rd December 2025
	4.2 Resolved that the third instalment of the grant for Ystradgynlais Welfare Hall and the payment of the capital grant is released.
	4.3 To note that the payment of accounts for December was approved and confirmed. It was clarified again that invoices from contractors should be more detailed and should be submitted two weeks prior to a meeting so that they can be scrutinised.

	4.4 To approve the following motion as proposed by Cllr M Donnelly, seconded by Cllr R Millington:- ‘That Ystradgynlais Town Council make a donation of £500 to Ystradgynlais Foodbank who are under severe financial pressure due to its commitment to deliver over 90 hampers this year to people in food poverty and that lack of finances may mean that they fall short of this target.’ Motion was passed and the donation will be released.
	4.5 Agreed that ordinary meetings would revert back to the first Thursday of the month after January.
	4.6 Agreed that B Morgan would look at updating the Town Council’s training plan in readiness for the new budget.
	4.7 Agreed that the produced Section 6 report could be published on the website and sent to One Voice Wales.
	4.8 Resolved that Cllr J Horrell would attend the One Voice Wales AGM on January 21st 2026 with Cllr W Thomas being the reserve. It was resolved that Cllr J Horrell should take to the AGM the decisions of the full Council regarding the motions.
	4.9 Resolved that the Clerk would feed back to Powys County Council regarding the proposed street name and numbering for the development North of Maes yr Ysgol.
	4.10 Agreed the Council would not request a copy of the Electoral Register.
	4.11 Agreed that Cllrs would send any comments regarding NESO and RESP to the Clerk for forwarding to the relevant authorities.
	4.12 Cllr G Davies was nominated as the new Town Council representative for Ysgol Bro Tawe Governing Body.
	4.13 Resolved that the Clerk would send the link to the hybrid planning meeting on December 18th regarding the land to the West of the former Penrhos School to those Cllrs who requested it.
	4.14 Resolved that the Clerk would write in response to the resident who had written in regarding illegal trading in Ystradgynlais and signpost them to the correct organisations.
	4.15 The written reports by the Clerk and the Facilities Manager were noted.
	4.16 Noted that the light switch on events in Ystradgynlais and Abercrave went well and thanks were given to those who had helped out at the events.

	4.17 Noted that the Council is still waiting for a response from Powys County Council regarding the issues with access along Gwysfryn.
	4.18 Noted that a court decision was imminent regarding the illegally parked cars on Gwysfryn.
	4.19 Noted that there were drainage issues on Gwysfryn and that a solution was being looked at.
	4.20 To submit observations regarding planning matters as agreed.
	4.21 Agreed that the draft contract and job description of the RFO role would be shared amongst the Full Council.
