	4.3 Resolved that the Town Council would write a letter to Powys THB regarding rumours surrounding the closure of beds in Ystradgynlais Community Hospital.
	4.4 Resolved to invite Roger Francis (Area Manager Housing Quality South) to a meeting with the Town Council regarding the access issue at Gwysfryn/Ynys Tre Deg.
	4.5 Resolved to contact the DVLA regarding the parked cars at Gwysfryn and tot follow up with the solicitor.
	4.6 Noted that the Youth Council had met and had elected a Chair and Vice-Chair.

	4.7 Noted that Councillors can attend County Planning, Taxi Licensing and Rights of Way Committee meetings which are held in Llandrindod Wells.
	4.8 Resolved that an Environment Committee/Working Group would be established with interested Cllrs to assist the Clerk in writing the Biodiversity Action Plan. The Clerk would contact OVW for guidance in setting up new committees.
	4.9 Resolved that any Cllrs interested in joining the Cross-border Healthcare meetings, organised by the Clerk in Llandrindod Wells, should contact the Clerk.

	4.11 Resolved that the Health & Safety Policy, the Welsh Language Policy and the Training Plan 2026/27, as recommended by the Management Committee were considered and approved, It was resolved that they would be published on the website and reviewed in 12 months time.
